Examples of areas to cover are:

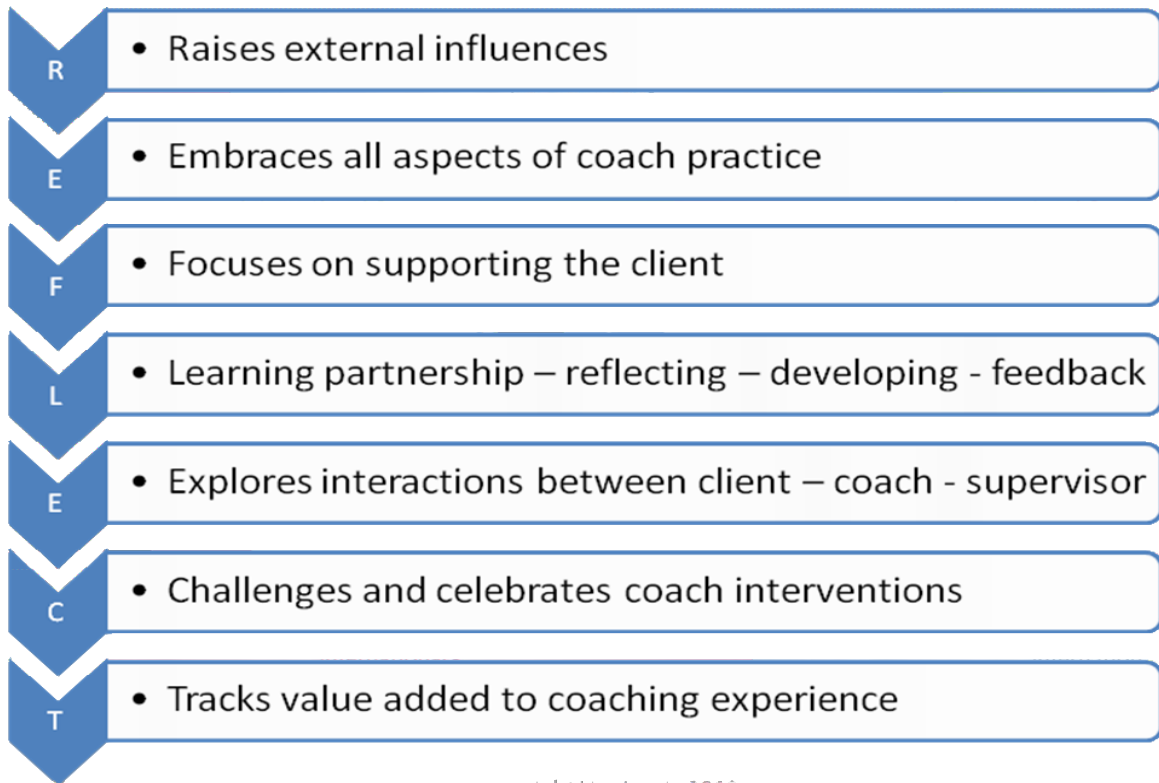
- Type of Coaching Supervision
